


# PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS,** today we celebrate the work of the Green Seattle Partnership, which is a partnership between the City of Seattle, Forterra, community-based groups, nonprofit organizations, businesses, schools and thousands of volunteers who are dedicated to restoring and maintaining 2,500 acres of forested parklands; and
